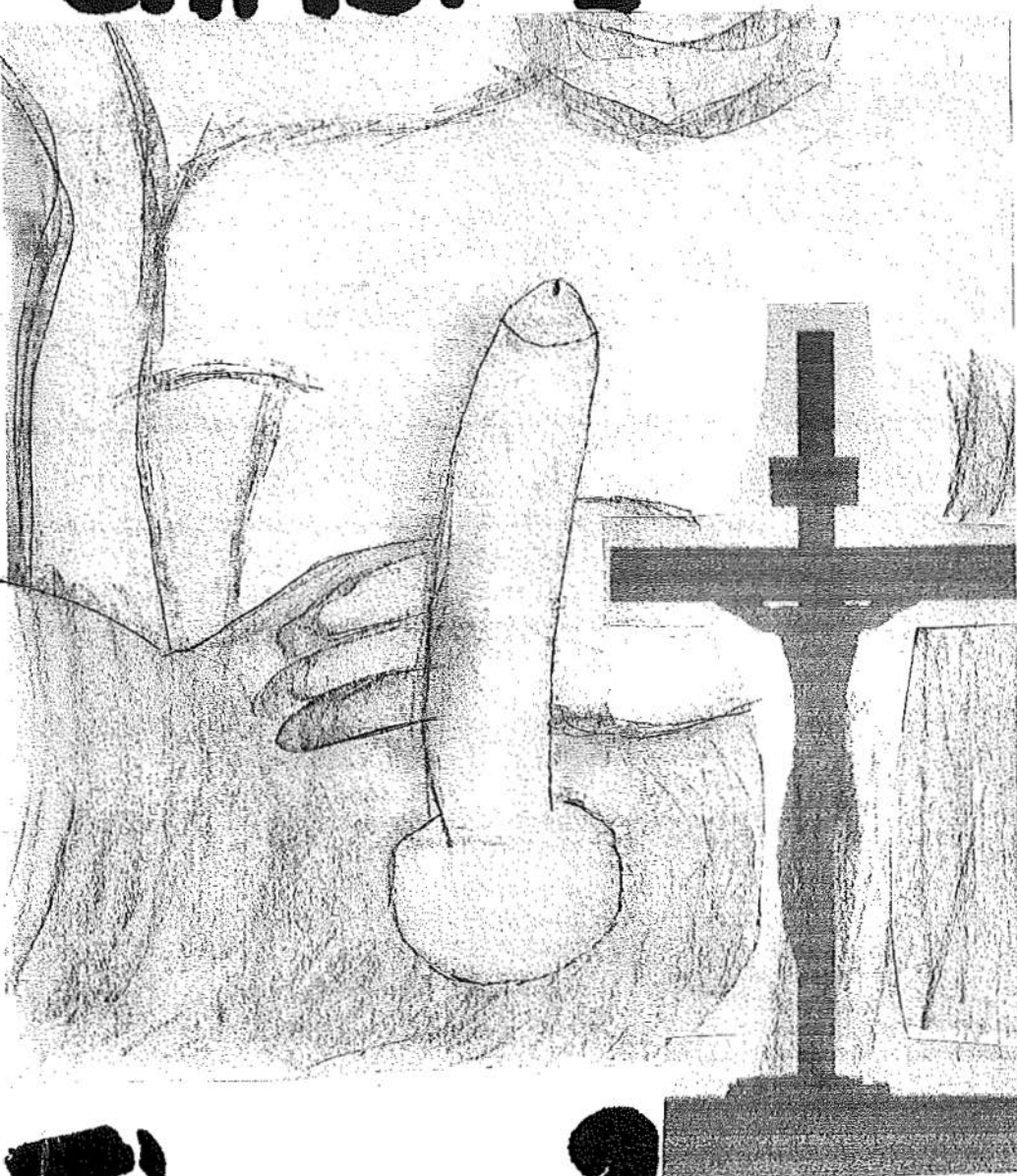

Becoming Christian

I do believe he's right, but it's very frustrating right now, desiring & hoping for these relationships in the future but not experiencing signs of moving completely in that direction. Basically, I don't want to be lonely all of my life.

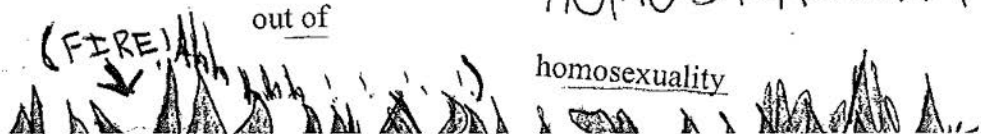

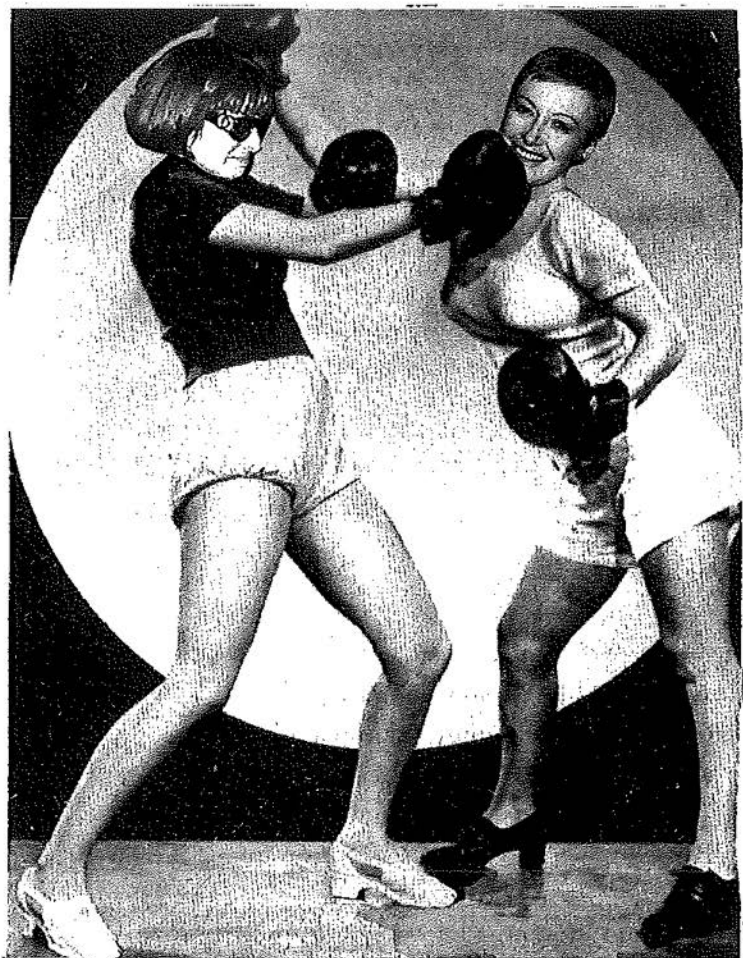

Dr. Ireland today. He asked what was on my mind and I had decided last night that I would just be honest + upfront with him today. I told him that over the past few weeks I'd been thinking a lot about killing myself. I explained how it's not so much that I've made a plan + am set on doing it but more so that it has emerged as an option in my mind recently as a response to my life + struggles. To my surprise he kind of freaked out. I mean, I guess I have to realize what his responsibility is as a psychologist when someone tells him they're thinking about suicide. So, we talked about why + how it has become an option for me - mostly because I just ~~cannot~~ see my future being any different than the present or my cyclical past of depression, questioning, hope, God, questioning, depression, hopelessness etc. There isn't anything that makes me believe my future will be different than this cycle. Living like this just doesn't have meaning or motivation, at all. His main response was that I Don't know what the future holds + it is completely inaccurate + wrong to just assume that I know how it'll be.

Then he asked what has/is keeping me from actually doing it. I explained how thinking of how my family/friends would be affected + how they'd react really scared me + makes me really sad. I don't want to make their lives completely hell

and ruined because I decided to do something really self-centered & directed for my "benefit." Also, the other big thing is that I don't want to dwell with this lingering thought in the back of my head about the question of God and eternity.

He pretty much threatened to report it/call my parents/etc. I had to explain & convince him that this isn't something I'm ready to do, just that it's something I've thought about.

He mentioned going to a doctor to see about anti-depressants, but he's not crazy about medicine & I'm not either, especially because my parents would find out and I don't want medicine to bring me into some unnaturally induced state of mediocrity & "complacency" with my life. I want to fucking deal with this shit once & for all. And I DON'T know how to do that - except for simply not living.

I feel like I'm going fucking insane.

- he's making me come in on Friday afternoon.


Coming Out Support Group

There's something I've wanted you to know Jan '11
for a long time, and that's why I'm writing
this letter. After you read it, I do not want
you to call or otherwise contact me (besides an
email saying only that you received it) until you've
had time to gather your thoughts and put them
down in the form of a letter ^{back} to me.

What I need you to know is that I am gay.
This is not a temporary phase or something someone
else convinced me to "do" or "try." I have been gay
for as long as I can remember and ~~will~~ that will not
change. Just so you know, I am out to all of my
~~many~~ friends and they have been wonderfully supportive
for years. I've gotten to the point in my life
where I want to only be surrounded by people who
love me for who I am - every part of me. My hope is
that you'll be a part of that category.

You're probably wondering what implications this has
for my spirituality + relationship with God. To be honest,
I'm not sure. What I can say is that I have certainly

not abandoned the ideas of spirituality + God. ~~And~~ I have spent COUNTLESS hours contemplating and discussing with others these issues and will continue to do so, so please do not assume this means I'm some ^{new} poor, soulless person now.

I am open to any questions you ~~may~~ might have but am not interested in sitting on the other end of the phone line while you cry. That may sound harsh, but please understand that I've spent my entire life thus far protecting others from what I perceived as information that'd be harmful to them - I can't do that any longer and now ~~there~~ ^{need} to focus on what is good, right, and healthy for me and what will allow me to develop and progress as an individual.

Hopefully all of this is making sense.

Like I said before, please send an email just saying that you received it. I will not answer your phone calls for right now, but will be looking for a letter with your thoughts/responses.
